State-of-the-art facilities

Our Health Education Center offers a patient-care clinic for dental hygiene, an \$11 million building for the College of Orthotics and Prosthetics, and a simulated hospital training facility that is fully equipped with patient simulators that allow students to practice clinical procedures. Our world-class Veterinary Technology facility features 32,000 square feet of state-of-the-art classrooms, labs, surgery and x-ray suites, kennels and offices.



Our planetarium is a "star theater" with a 24-foot domed ceiling that can accurately simulate the night sky at any time or location on Earth. Our rooftop observatory and observation deck feature several types of telescopes for both day and night star gazing.



The Engineering, Manufacturing and Building Arts community features an open manufacturing factory work environment to train tomorrow's engineering technology and manufacturing employees. The Center was equipped based on input from local industry.
